

Setting up TrueCrypt on your Corsair USB Flash Drive

The intent of this guide is to point you quickly to the sections of interest for setting up TrueCrypt on your Corsair USB Flash Drive.

What is TrueCrypt? TrueCrypt is a full featured file encryption program that has many features and functions beyond providing a secure partition on your Corsair USB Flash Drive. For more information on TrueCrypt, please refer to the User's Guide (which is included as part of the TrueCrypt installation) and the TrueCrypt website (<http://www.truecrypt.org>) .

System Requirements:

- One available USB 2.0 port
- Windows XP, 2K and Vista

First install TrueCrypt onto your computer. This can be done by double-clicking the "*Truecrypt-4.3*" folder and then double-clicking "*TrueCrypt Setup.exe*". Both the "*Truecrypt-4.3*" folder and "*TrueCrypt Setup.exe*" file are stored on the Corsair USB Flash Drive. You can also download the zip file archive of the latest version of the software from the TrueCrypt website. To install from a downloaded zip file, first extract the contents of the zip file and then double-click "*TrueCrypt Setup.exe*".

Note that you must have administrator privileges on the computer that you would like to install TrueCrypt on.

If you do not have administrator privileges, please request that your system administrator install TrueCrypt, or have the system administrator give you administrator privileges on the computer you would like to install TrueCrypt on. Once TrueCrypt has been installed on a computer, it can be run by a user without administrator privileges.

After you have installed TrueCrypt, follow the "Beginner's Tutorial" in the User's Guide. The User's Guide can be found by clicking on Start → Programs → TrueCrypt → TrueCrypt User's Guide after you have installed TrueCrypt or from the TrueCrypt online User's Guide at <http://www.truecrypt.org/user-guide/> (select "Beginner's Tutorial" from the chapter listing).

TrueCrypt can be carried with you on your Corsair USB Flash Drive. To set this up, refer to the "Traveller Mode" chapter in the User's Guide, and follow the instructions under the "Tools → Traveller Disk Setup" section. These instructions can also be found by selecting "Traveller Mode" from the chapter list for the online TrueCrypt User's Guide.

Alternate Language Support

The default language for TrueCrypt is English; however, there are many language packages available for free download on the TrueCrypt website. Please go to <http://www.truecrypt.org/localizations.php> to see the available alternate language support and further instructions on how to install a language package.
